Monash Pharmacy Internship Program

In order to become a practicing pharmacist, the Pharmacy Board of Victoria requires graduates to undertake the equivalent of one year internship (supervised training) followed by a registration examination. The one year of supervised training is a combination of practical 'on the job' training and completion of an approved pharmacy internship program. Monash University offers the educational component of the internship training.

The Monash Pharmacy Internship Program (formerly known as the Pharmacy Pre-registration Program) will assist pharmacy graduates in making the transition from student to independent, competent professional. The course has a very practical focus that helps students consolidate and build upon the knowledge and skills gained as an undergraduate and apply these to their practice as a pharmacist.

Monash University's Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Pharmacy/Commerce are accredited by the Pharmacy Board of Victoria.
